1. The Super Stack Leader Board Promotion will begin Wednesday, April 15th, 2009.
2. Player will receive points based on final table finishes in all Super Stack Tournaments (BR09-007)
3. The top 40 players in points earned for each session will receive a free entry into a \$10,000 Prize pool No Limit Holdem Tournament.
4. The sessions are as follows:
Session 1: April 15th-May 29th, Freeroll tournament to be played at 6PM on Sunday, June 7th, 2009.
June 1st-June 30th, Freeroll to be played on Sunday July 12th, 2009
July 1st-July 31st, Freeroll to be played on Sunday, August 9th, 2009
August 1st-August 28th, Freeroll to be played on Sunday, August 30th, 2009
5. 1 Point will be earned for each tournament entry.
6. Points will be awarded for "in the money finishes" with the following values assigned by order of finish in qualifying tournaments:

36 or more players

7. The Beau Rivage Super Stack Freeroll Tournaments will be held on the following dates at 6:00PM: June 7th, 2009, July 12th, 2009, August 9th, 2009, and August 30th, 2009.
8. The prize pool will be \$10,000.
9. The prize pool will be funded from the Beau Rivage Poker Promotions Fund.
10. Registration will begin one hour prior to the start of the tournament.
11. *There will be no entry fee or administration for this tournament.* Players will qualify by earning points in Super Stack tournaments from April 15th-August 28th.
